No partial refund can be given for classes not attended and no postponement can be allowed. Fees will be refunded only if a course is cancelled due to an insufficient number of students (we aim for a minimum class size of 6 and a maximum of 14).

Please note that the Italian Institute will be closed on Wednesday, 1st May and Monday, 27th May for public holidays. The classes will be postponed to week commencing Monday, 24th June (same day/time as regular classes).
